

'23-'24 Season Virtual Audition Instructions

VIOLIN

[Prelude + Etude]

For the virtual audition, you'll have to record a video of yourself performing the following 3 things:
 Scales, a Prepared Solo, and an Instrument Excerpt.

Before you begin, make sure you've done your best to set up your recording so that we can see all of your playing/instrument and so that you will sound your best (look on Acceptd for many helpful videos and tips). Lastly, <u>make sure that you read this through a couple of times before you begin</u> so that you remember the order of everything. We recommend that you **print this page and use it when you're recording so you don't forget anything.**

***Important—Please announce the following that at the start of your video:
Full Name -> Instrument -> Which orchestra you're auditioning for (Prelude OR
Etude).....Then be sure to announce each part of the audition before you play it.

1) Scales:

(Remember to announce each scale before playing)

- **Prelude:** 3 scales (1 octave)
 - C major, D major, and G major
- **Etude**: 5 scales (1 or 2 octaves, if able)
 - C major, D major, G major, F major, and A major

Play your scales slowly, one note to a bow, focusing on your tone and intonation.

2) Prepared Solo:

(Remember to announce your solo name and composer before starting)

- Pick a solo that shows us your best playing (around 1 minute in length).

3) Instrument Excerpt:

(Remember announce each excerpt before you play it)

*Everyone should play Excerpt #1.


**ONLY ETUDE applicants should play Excerpt #2
