STATE OF TENNESSEE

Charter of Incorporation

Be it Known, That P.M. Cox, Alexander Curry, O.K. Logan, Stella Wistner, Lawrence H. Calloway, and Harry Miller

are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name and style of **Chattanooga Symphony Association, The**
 purpose of this association is to awaken, stimulate, and promote better interest in
 music for the advancement of culture.

The general powers of said corporation shall be: To use and be used by the corporate name; to have and use a common seal, which it may alter at pleasure; if no common seal, then the signature of the name of the corporation by any duly authorized officer shall be legal and binding; to purchase and hold, or receive by gift, bequest, or devise, in addition to the personal property owned by said corporation, real estate necessary for the transaction of the corporate business, and also to purchase or accept any real estate in payment or in part payment of any debt due to the corporation, and all the same shall be by laws, and make all rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the laws of this State, for the management of corporate affairs, and to appoint such subordinate officers and agents, in addition to the President and Secretary or Treasurer, as the business of the corporation may require, designate the name of the officers and the compensation of the officers.

The said corporation shall maintain a convenient office in the city of Chattanooga, Tennessee, for the registration of this charter in the office of the Secretary of State, elect from their number a President, Secretary, and Treasurer, or the last two officers may be combined; the officers shall have no term of office, and they shall incorporate to constitute the first Board of Directors. In all elections each member to be entitled to one vote, either in person or by proxy, and the result to be determined by a majority of the votes cast. Due notice of any election must be given by advertisement in a newspaper, personal notice to the members, or a day stated on the minutes of the Board six months preceding the election. The Board of Directors shall keep a record of all their proceedings, which shall be at all times subject to the inspection of any member. The corporation may establish branches in any other county in the State.

The Board of Directors may have the power to increase the number of Directors, if they deem the interest of the corporation requires such increase. And the first or any subsequent Board of Directors may have the power to elect other members, who, on acceptance of membership, shall become corporators equally with the original corporators. The Board of Directors shall have the right to determine what amount of money paid into the treasury shall be a prerequisite for membership, or, if necessary, what amount shall be thus annually paid, and failure thus to pay shall, in the discretion of the Directors, justify the expulsion of said defaulting member. The term of all officers may be fixed by the by-laws, the said term not, however, to exceed three years. All officers hold over until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

The general welfare of society, not individual profit, is the object for which this charter is granted, and hence the members are not stockholders in the legal sense of the term, and no dividends or profits shall be divided among the members. The members may at any time voluntarily dissolve the corporation by a conveyance of its assets and property to any other corporation holding a charter from the State for the purposes not of individual profit, first providing for corporate debts.

A violation of any of the provisions of this charter shall subject the corporation to dissolution at the instance of the State.

This charter is subject to modification or amendment; and in case said modification or amendment is not accepted, corporate business is to cease, and the assets and property, after payment of debts, are to be conveyed, as aforesaid, to some other corporation holding a charter for purposes not connected with individual profit. Acquiescence in any modification thus declared shall be determined in a meeting specially called for that purpose, and only those voting in favor of the modification shall thereafter compose the corporation.

The means, assets, income, or other property of the corporation shall not be employed directly or indirectly for any other purpose whatever than to accomplish the legitimate objects of its creation, and by no implication shall it possess the power to issue notes or currency, deal in currency, notes, or coin, buy or sell products, or engage in any kind of trading operation, nor hold any more real estate than is necessary for legitimate purposes.

Expulsion shall be the only remedy for the nonpayment of dues by the members, and there shall be no individual liability against the members for corporate debts, but the entire corporate property shall be liable for the claims of creditors.

We, the undersigned, apply to the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the laws of the land, for a Charter of Incorporation for the purposes and with the powers, etc., declared in the foregoing instrument.

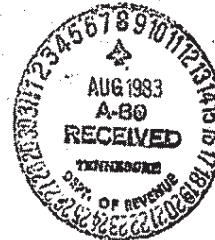

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 48-303 of the Tennessee General Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Charter:

A. The name of the corporation is CHATTANOOGA SYMPHONY ASSOCIATION.

B. The amendment adopted is the deletion of all prior articles contained in the Charter of the corporation and replacing such articles with the following:

1. The name of the corporation is CHATTANOOGA SYMPHONY ASSOCIATION.

2. The address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Tennessee shall be 8 Patten Parkway, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37402, County of Hamilton.

3. The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

4. The corporation is not for profit.

5. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, including but not limited to the stimulation and promotion of better interest in music for the advancement of culture and the performance of symphonic works and the training of persons therefor.

6. Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Charter, the corporation shall only conduct or carry on activities permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the

Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and its Regulations and by any organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code and Regulations.

7. The corporation is to have no members.

8. The number of elected directors shall be set by the entire board of directors but shall not be less than three (3); provided, however, that the initial number of directors whose terms shall begin as of the first meeting held after May 31, 1984, shall be fifty-five (55) chosen as follows: twenty (20) elected by the Chattanooga Symphony Association; twenty (20) elected by the Chattanooga Opera Association; four (4) elected by the guild of this corporation; and eleven (11) elected by the foregoing forty-four (44) directors of this corporation. The directors elected by the guild of this corporation shall serve such term, not exceeding three (3) years, as the guild may determine. The directors who are elected to the board of directors may be divided into two (2) or more classes for terms of office which may expire at different times.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed, in accordance with a plan of distribution adopted by the board of directors, exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational organizations which are engaged in affairs substantially similar to those of the dissolving corporation and which would qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations, or, if the assets are to be used exclusively for public purposes, to a local or state government or the Federal government, or an agency thereof.

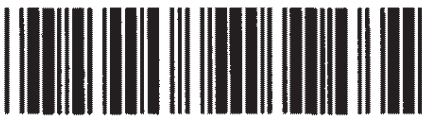

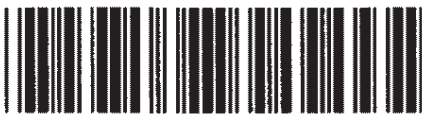
